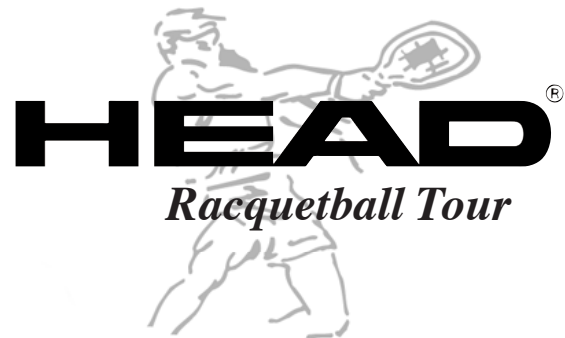

ELIGIBILITY & SANCTIONING

All participants must be current residents of the State of Ohio (except for Collegiate Divisions). All HEAD Tour events are ORA/USAR sanctioned. You must be a member to play. If you are not, memberships will be available at the event. The cost is \$50 per year for an ORA/USAR competitive license or \$20 for a Limited Athlete Weekend License. A competitive license will allow you to receive numerous benefits throughout the year.
